A RESOLUTION TO CONSOLIDATE SOLID WASTE DUTIES WITH THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING DIRECTOR DUTIES

WHEREAS, Buffalo County has entered into a long-term agreement with La Crosse County for the disposal of waste at the waste-to-energy facility operated by Excel Energy; and,

WHEREAS, NR 544.04 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code requires that an effective recycling program must include provisions for the management of postconsumer waste that is not separated or recovered for recycling in a manner consistent with management priorities set by state law; and,

WHEREAS, modifying the position description of the Emergency Management and Recycling Director to include duties of the Solid Waste Director is in the best interest of Buffalo County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the position description of the Emergency Management and Recycling Director include duties of the Solid Waste Director.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Solid Waste duties will be funded through the Administration budget in a designated account based on actual time spent performing these activities.
