## RESOLUTION # 16-03-04

### A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING COUNTY CONSERVATIONIST AS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF DNR TARGETED RUNOFF MANAGEMENT GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Buffalo County Land Conservation and Resource Management Department hereby requests financial and technical assistance for landowners under s. 281.65 and 281.66, Wis. Stats. And ch. NR 151, 153, and 155 Wis. Admin. Code, and

WHEREAS, funds that are requested through the WI-DNR Targeted Runoff Management Program, are state grant funds allocated for the purpose of implementing measures to address nonpoint source pollution abatement, land and water priorities, goals, and objectives as specified in the Buffalo County Land and Water Resource Management Plan, and


WHEREAS, this grant program requires specific tasks to be completed and routine signatures of an "Authorized Representative" or similar to submit and accept grants, submit reimbursement requests, and other forms necessary in the administration of these grants,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the County Conservationist the authority to sign and submit a grant application, sign a grant agreement between the Land Conservation and Resource Management Department and WI-DNR, sign agreements and make cost-share payments to landowner/operators for installing best management practices, submit interim and final reports, and request grant reimbursements to support landowners that seek to construct conservation practices, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Land Conservation and Resource Management Committee be authorized to sign these same documents in the absence of the Buffalo County Conservationist.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Buffalo County shall comply with all state and federal laws, regulations and permit requirements pertaining to implementation of this grant program and to fulfillment of the grant document provisions.

Adopted at a duly called and noticed meeting of the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016.


