A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY BUFFALO COUNTY TO OPERATE A MULTI-COUNTY AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 46.283 certain duties and responsibilities are outlined related to operating a multi-county resource center for older people, people with disabilities, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 46.283, the Wisconsin State Department of Health Services (DHS) shall develop and implement a comprehensive strategy to involve counties in the delivery of services for older people and people with disabilities, protect adults, and promote responsible stewardship of human and fiscal resources in the provision of such services; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Buffalo County to join up with Pepin County to form a multi-county resource center to maximize efficiencies through shared functions and funding; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) is to provide equal access to high quality information and referral services for adults with long term care needs and in need of protection; and

WHEREAS, the purpose to be achieved of the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) will be to strive to provide and serve as the single access point for publicly funded long term care and protective services with a resource with offices located in each county and staffed by employees with funding from the State; and

WHEREAS, the intent of this resolution is supported by the Department of Health and Human Services Committee who serve as the Commission on Aging for the County; and,

WHEREAS, the intent of this resolution is to authorize the Buffalo County Health and Human Services Director in collaboration with Pepin County to submit an application and to enter into any and all contracts or other documents necessary to create, form, authorize, and/or operate the multi-county initiative of which Buffalo County will be a member; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Buffalo County Board of Supervisors does hereby declare its intent to join the multi-county ADRC long term services and adult protective services and authorizes the Buffalo County Department of Health and Human Services Director to submit an application for a multi-county ADRC in collaboration with Pepin County and to enter into any and all contracts or other documents necessary to create, form, authorize and operate the multi-county ADRC; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Buffalo County Department of Health and Human Services Director and the County Administrative Coordinator are authorized to take any other actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
