A RESOLUTION TO FUND COST SHARING FOR BUFFALO COUNTY CONSERVATION STRUCTURES DAMAGED BY 2016 FLOODS

WHEREAS, Buffalo County proudly promotes and supports land and water conservation structure implementation and repairs to reverse the effects of excessive soil erosion and water pollution runoff to state waters for the benefit of all Buffalo County citizens; and

WHEREAS, Buffalo County landowners have built and maintained such structures for many years to the benefit of all Buffalo County citizens; and

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2016, heavy rains inflicted widespread damage throughout portions of Buffalo County, resulting in flash flooding, landslides, and river flooding. A significant amount of sediment and debris washed into cropped fields, pastures, drainage ways, and conservation structures. Approximately 2,000 conservation structures have been estimated damaged due to overtopping, washouts, and a large amount of sediment, rocks, and sticks accumulating on trash tracks; and

WHEREAS, financial aid in the form of cost-sharing for the flood damaged conservation structures would aid those land owners, as well as all citizens in the county; and

WHEREAS, the project will target repair to government designed conservation structures located on private land in Buffalo County. Eligible landowners would be required to meet a \$1,000 deductible per structure and abide by the terms of the cost-share agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Land Conservation and Resource Management Committee has reviewed and supports the request to use CAPX2020 funding for the conservation repair projects; and

WHEREAS, the Buffalo County Finance Committee has reviewed and supports the request to use up to \$150,000 of CAPX2020 funding for the conservation structure repair projects, subject to a deductible and 50% matching funds from the landowner.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby grants authorization to allocate \$150,000 of CAPX2020 funds for conservation structure repair subject to the landowner paying a \$1,000 deductible and 50% matching funds, with coordination from the Land Conservation and Resource Management Department and Committee, subject to approval by the Public Service Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the individual plans be approved by the Land Conservation Department and proposals be subject to the bidding process with oversight by the Land Conservation Department and Land Conservation Committee.




