RESOLUTION # 18-12-14

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR SERVICES OF COUNTY CORONER

WHEREAS, Sec. 59.36, Wis. Stats. provides that the County Board shall set fees for all services rendered by the coroner; and,

WHEREAS, 2015 Wisconsin Act 336 placed a moratorium on increases in various fees related to coroner that ended on April 17, 2017; and,

WHEREAS after the moratorium, the County Board may increase the amount of the fees for services rendered by a coroner, fees assessed for the signing of a death certificate and fees related to transportation services not exceed the annual percentage change in the U.S. Consumer Price Index, for the 12 months ending on December 31st of the year before the increase.

WHEREAS, said fees need to be revised from time to time based upon increased costs to Buffalo County in providing these services and the County Coroner recommends that the fees be adjusted; and,

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee, at its November 21, 2018 meeting, recommended the fees be modified as follows for 2019 based on the 2017 Consumer Price Index of 2.1%:

	Current Fee	Proposed Fee
Cremation Permit	\$ 125.00	\$ 127.50
Disinterment Permit	\$ 50.00	\$ 51.00
Death Certificate Processing	\$ 30.00	\$ 30.50

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the fees as set forth above, effective on January 1, 2019 and that each December the fees are adjusted not to exceed the annual percentage change in the U.S. Consumer Price Index, for the 12 months ending on December 31st of the year before the increase.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Buffalo County Coroner shall collect the established fees, maintain auditable records, and deposit those fees with the Buffalo County Treasurer on a monthly basis.
