Community Service Report: Gina reported on numbers, some recent failures. See attached report.

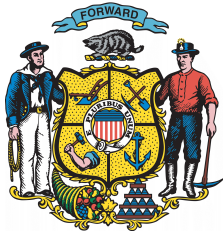
