**Review/ Update on CDBG – Trout Angling in the Driftless Area**

Ms. Carrie Olson, Buffalo County Conservationist share with the committee the county's pledge of \$100,000 to match 10:1 for a trout unlimited program to improve fishing conditions in the county. She also described the digitization of the access points utilizing bridges and right of way property. She wanted everyone to be aware of the tremendous efforts being put forward by the various clubs working on this project.
