- **#1.** Call to Order/Roll call: Sheriff Michael Schmidtknecht, Vice-Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:00pm.
- **#2.** Recognition of good Samaritans-moved to accommodate attendance
- **#3. Approval of April Minutes:** Motion to approve previous Minutes made by Mr. Reed, Second by Mr. Tumaniec., Motion carried.
- **#4. R/D/A-Medical Representative position:** Norita Willadsen put in her resignation notice mid-June. The DOT planned to acknowledge her years of service on their own merit. Discussion of vacated medical position was had. Sheriff Schmidtknecht shared with the committee Beth Sass as a possible new member. He explained that he was aware that she had shown interest in the committee and would be a good fit based upon her medical background. Mr. Platteter made a motion to bring forward Ms. Sass' name to the county board for consideration of appointment to the highway safety committee to fill the vacated medical position, second by Mr. Reed. Motion carried.
- #5. Citizen concerns on posted Agenda items: None
- #6. Citizen concerns on non-posted Agenda items: None
- **#7. Sheriff's Update:** Sheriff Schmidtknecht advised the committee of a three vehicle accident with a fatality near Fountain City Kwik Trip, which is a still under investigation. There possibly could've been a medical issue.

ATV/UTV increasing concerns. Roads are not to be used until official posting of signage and posting in the paper is done. Chief Deputy Engfer advised within the first 6 months, DNR reported 16 UTV fatalities, 12 of them were on roadways.

- **#2. Recognition of good Samaritans:** Sheriff Schmidtknecht advised the committee of the "above and beyond" acts performed by David Harr, Jeremy Tenney, Shawn Gunderson-not present, Ross Patzner-not present, and Cole Anderson-who appeared virtually, due to his military assignment, during an accident that occurred on April 5, 2021 in Fountain City involving a log truck and SUV.
- **#8. Emergency Management Report:** Sheriff Schmidtknecht read Mr. Fuerbringer's report to the committee. Mr. Fuerbringer has been working on adjusting the EM performance grant, which funds 50% of the EM grant. He was advised that due to changes to the grant, the previously submitted request for mobile squad radios for LE has been denied and are no longer eligible, therefore, the grant needed modification to only purchase radios for EM. The EPCRA grant was recently submitted. He plans to officially retire when a new replacement has been named. The new replacement will now be considered a 50% EM and 50% Risk Management position. Mr. Fuerbringer plans to aid the new hire into their new role with Buffalo County.

Sheriff Schmidtknecht advised Chief Johnson reported that the City passed the use of a ATV/UTV, however, signage needs to be up first which should be completed in the fall.

- **#9. Bob Platteter Highway Dept. update**: Mr. Platteter advised ATV signs will only be put up entering/exiting the county, on county posts (not stop signs). Signs will not be posted until notice goes into the paper.
- **#10. Dan Kontos-DOT update:** Mr. Kontos reported 95 total crashes as of July 14th. Speed is still 28.4% main reason for the accidents. One fatality for the year for Buffalo County. Predictive Analytics, based upon previous 5 year crash data, highest crash probability is a 1.00 mile area in Fountain City.

- **#11. Rick Tumaniec-DOT update:** Mr. Tumaniec advised there will be no interference with the Ashley for the Arts festivities with the scheduled Highway 93 work.
- #12. Jeri Baures-Population update: None
- **#13. Josh Reed-Education update:** Mr. Reed advised of awareness of drivers and buses as the new school year approaches. He asked if there would be any education for etiquette around buses that could be shared. The school is thinking about moving some of the drop off points.
- **#14. Sergeant Haigh-WSP update:** The state patrol will be transferring a new trooper to the area in the near future.

### **#15.** Medical update: vacant

Next meeting is set for October 21st at 1:00pm.

Mr. Platteter made a motion for adjournment, second by Mr. Kontos. Adjournment at 1:54pm.
