## A RESOLUTION FOR 2022 BUFFALO COUNTY SUPERVISORY REDISTRICTING BOUNDARIES PLAN

WHEREAS, periodic political seat reapportionment and boundary redistricting are mandated by federal and state law, specifically Wisconsin Statute 59.10 requires governments in Wisconsin to redistrict following completion of the federal ten-year (decennial) census; and,


WHEREAS, members of the Buffalo County Committee of the Board and Finance Committees have undertaken a review of the current supervisory districting representation for Buffalo County in light of recent federal census information; and,


WHEREAS, members of these Committees have recommended the boundary of the Buffalo County Supervisory Districts remain at the current level of fourteen (14) districts; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors authorizes the adoption of the tentative County Supervisory Redistricting Plan and transmit the tentative plan to each municipal governing body in the county for their action regarding the creation or adjustment of ward lines, if any, in accordance with the tentative county supervisory redistricting plan.
