**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DONATION TO THE BUFFALO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FROM YE OLD SCHOOLHOUSE SHOPPE FOR K-9 PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 59.52(19), Wis. Stats. empowers the County Board of Supervisors to accept donations, gifts, or grants of money for any public governmental purpose within the powers of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Buffalo County Sheriff's Office employs a K-9 by the name of Owen, who is fully certified, trained in narcotics detection, and is capable to search for missing persons; and,

**WHEREAS**, Buffalo County Sheriff's Office relies on outside, cash donations to maintain the K-9 program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Ye Old SchoolHouse Shoppe wishes to support the Buffalo County Sheriff's Office K-9 program with a cash donation in the amount of \$7,486.83. This donation covers the cost of necessary and K-9 specific equipment used to upfit the K-9 squad; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby accepts the cash donation from Ye Old SchoolHouse Shoppe and extends its appreciation for their support.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the funds be deposited into the designated K9 Account, maintained by the Buffalo County Sheriff's Office, which is annually audited by the contracted auditor for the County, and authorizes the Buffalo County Sheriff's Office to expend funds as necessary.


